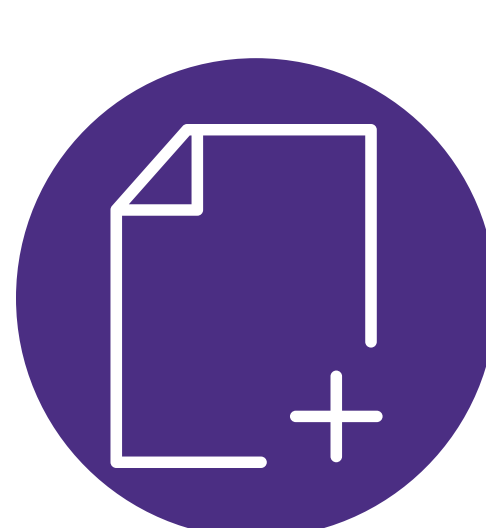

### Bluebooking & Publication Support

Research Publications Editor Cindy Fester provides a number of support to UW Law faculty working on publications (journal articles, book chapters, books, briefs, blog posts, op-ed pieces, etc.).

Our Bluebooking service is available to help UW Law faculty format their footnotes in ready-to-submit manuscripts to ensure conformity with the Bluebook.

Other publication support we provide includes: proofreading and formatting manuscripts, preparing permalinks for URLs, incorporating style sheets in manuscript formatting, providing templates and formatting for journal articles, and creating tables of contents, tables of authorities, and tables of cases.

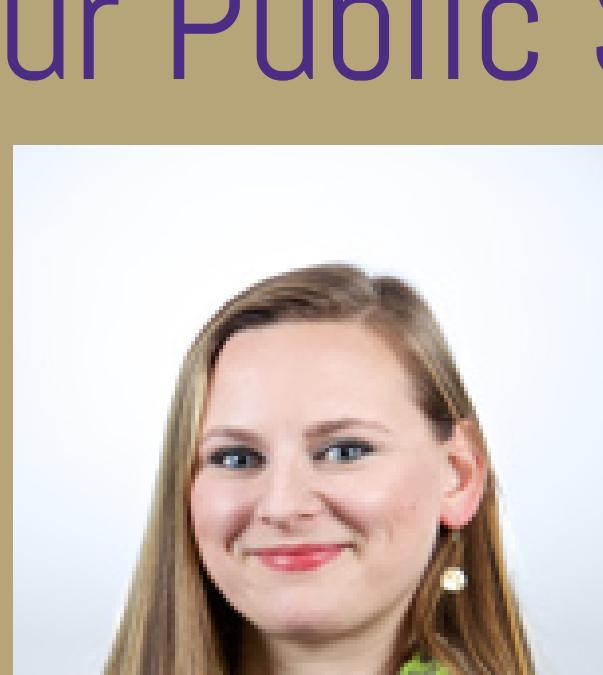
### Database Training

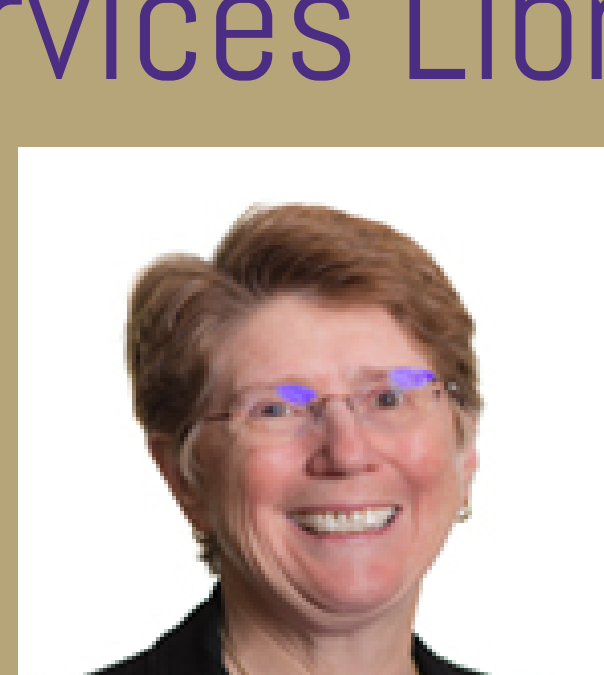

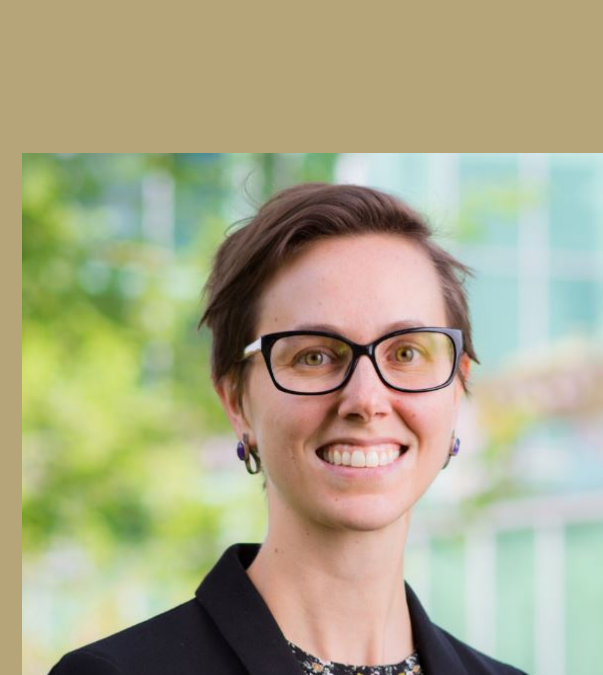
